Unfortunately, as we all know the season had to be cut short due to the Global COVID-19 pandemic. See below an extract from an update sent out to all members on 24th April 2020:

The committee had a telephone conference on the evening of Monday 20th April to discuss the ongoing situation and to decide on what this means for ADTTA’s 2019-20 season.

We discussed options regarding the potential to continue the season beyond April, including potential or likely availability of venues and players across our leagues.

It was decided by majority vote to end the season where we currently stand, as any other option did not appear to be practical.

Although regrettable, as a committee we did not feel that we had any other practical choice available to us that could be applied equally across all clubs and teams.

We also discussed what this would mean for our competitions (prior to the above vote).

For the cup competitions (League Cup & KO Cup), none of them are at the stage where they could practically be completed within the season.

Cup competitions are declared null and void for the 2019-20 season.

League competitions were declared, by unanimous vote, sufficiently far enough advanced that the Divisional titles could be awarded to the teams currently at the top of the division.
