Sussex Cadet Novice CLOSED RULES

- 1. The Sussex Cadet Novice is open to table tennis players of cadet U15 (Born After 2009), who are eligible to play for Sussex &
- Every entrant must be affiliated as a 'Compete Member' or be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF. It is not possible to acquire membership of Table Tennis England at the tournament. https://www.tabletennisengland.co.uk/membership/individual-membership/compete-membership
- 3. Eligibility NOVICE: Is aware of the rules of the game; Can serve within the rules; Can hold rallies;
- 4. There is a dress code, which is Sports Shorts & T-Shirt/Polo Shirt, neither of which should be predominantly White and sports shoes. Female attire skorts/skirt and dresses, leggings or all in one outfits.
- 5. All play will be best of five games.
- 6. Tables will be available for practice when not in use at the discretion of the Organiser.
- 7. The event is sponsored by the SCTTA and will be played under Table Tennis England Rules and Regulations.
