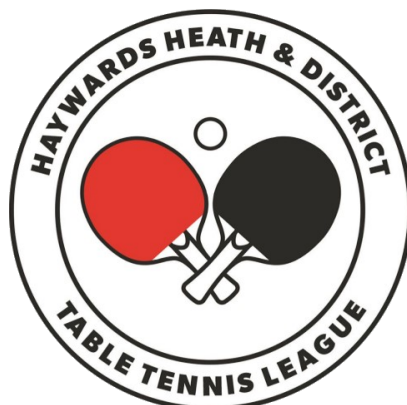

## Regulations

The tournament will be conducted in accordance with the present Laws of Table Tennis and the rules and regulations of Table Tennis England, including the regulations for dress.

The organising committee reserves the right to refuse any entry, to cancel any event for which insufficient entries are received and to make any alteration which it may deem necessary.

Each match in the tournament including the final shall be decided on the best of five sets, with sets being played up to 11 points or by 2 points if the score reaches 10-10.

Individual trophies will be awarded to winners and runners-up.

All events are seeded. The seeding of competitors and the draw will take place prior to the tournament and will be carried out by the organising committee.

**Competitors must arrive at least 15 minutes before their first event, earlier if they wish to warm up before commencing their event.**

Any competitor failing to report when required to play will be liable to disqualification. Please help by being punctual at all times throughout the day when called to play.

Competitors must be available to play at the time required and must not leave the playing venue whilst still involved in a competition without the prior approval of the referee. Timings for events and rounds may be subject to last minute changes during the day. Matches will be brought forward if possible to help maintain the overall timetable. A maximum of 5 minutes resting time will be given to a player between knockout rounds.

The expedite time limit rule will apply throughout the Championships.

**It is essential for the smooth running of the Championships that the losing players umpire the following match and all players must accept this responsibility.**

There will be no official lunch break.

It is hoped that most finals and semi-finals can be played as feature matches, with everyone else watching.

No food or drink will be available. Please bring your own

## **PROVISIONAL SCHEDULE**

The details given below are a provisional programme for the guidance of competitors only. It may be subject to alteration by the Referee depending on the number of entries received for each event.

### **09:00 - HANDICAP SINGLES competition**

This gives a chance to EVERY league player. Handicaps are decided on by ranking participating players using player averages as a guide in their respective divisions. This event will be played in groups of four as far as possible. The top two players in each group will then progress to a knockout draw.

### **12:00 - JUNIOR SINGLES competition**

This event will be played in groups. The top two players in each group will then progress to a knockout draw.

### **12:00 - VETERAN SINGLES competition**

This event will initially be played in groups. The top two players in each group will then progress to a knockout draw.

### **12:00 - WOMENS SINGLES competition (as available)**

This event will initially be played in groups. The top two players in each group will then progress to a knockout draw.

### **15:00 - CHAMPIONSHIP SINGLES competitions**

The **Premier Singles Competition** - open to all league players.

The **Divisional Singles Championship** - primarily open to conference players.

Both competitions will start with a group stage and evolve into a knockout. The decision as to whether a consolation competition will be played will be made at a later date as it is dependent on the number of entries.

### **18:00 - OPEN DOUBLES competition**

This event will initially be played in KNOCKOUT STAGE.
