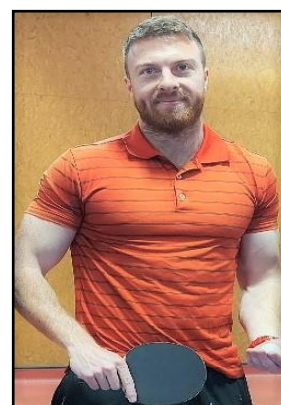
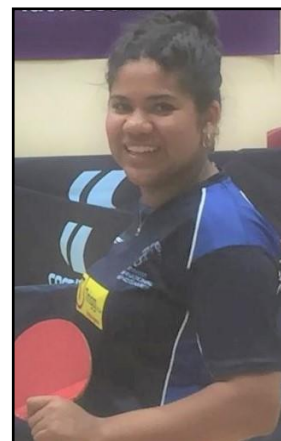
The NatWest International Island Games started in 1985 on the Isle of Man and have taken place every 2 years since then.
