## **NOTES:**

- 1. Game 2 in AvX was a deuce game. This happens as in regular table tennis.**
- 2. Player C starts on -2, therefore he should start all his games on 0 and upon reaching 2 points won, he'll return back to 0 (ensuring he has to get at least 23 point to win a game).**
- 3. All three of X, Y and Z would start their games, irrespective of who against.**
- 4. When player A plays, they will start on +1 in all matches and therefore neither player starts on 0 in matches involving player A. Due to scaling, in the AvY match, a starting score of 1-12 is correct, not 0-11, as this disadvantages the weaker player. Similarly, if two players were to start on negative handicaps as that would disadvantage the stronger player.**
- 5. Game 3 in BvZ would not have featured a change of ends since the lower handicapped player did not make it to 10 points.**
- 6. The match was over after game 7 since Castaways could no longer win, and because Neil is in the team, both teams agreed to finish there and go to the pub instead of playing out the remaining matches. This is not encouraged, but is acceptable if agreed by both teams.**
