COMMENTARY

Week 23

The week begins with Treasury A beating Outcasts 9-1. Eight of the ten sets were resolved three straight. Simon Jameson took an end off Giovanni Giuffrida and Perry Fung but Outcasts' sole success came in the form of a three straight win for Andrew Macalister over Giuffrida. 9-1 to Treasury A and only an extraordinary upset can keep their hands off the title. In the previous Bulletin I said Insurance had the best chance of pulling off a surprise result this week. How wrong I was as Employment whitewashed them 10-0! Part of the explanation lay in the players involved - Employment put out their best team while Insurance were understrength. Paul Brady, who's an 80% guy playing regularly in Division 2, pushed Paul Baylis quite close but lost over four ends. Albert Francis took an end off Chris McKee but got no further. A feature of the last month has been how well Richard Oppenheim is playing and he posted another maximum, dropping one end to Jon Velinor. Richard now has 12 successive wins in an unbroken streak. A marathon end between Richard and Paul Brady ended 20-18 in Richard's favour. Comets have struggled to field three players in the second half and finding themselves again with two had little chance against Morpeth. Greg Gargrupe beat Stuart Sweeney, lost to Terese Johannson in four but made little ground against Rob Chambers. Steve Fagan lost ends to Sweeney and Johannson but came through unscathed. Most interesting set of the night was Steve against Rob who started at a sprint and took the first two ends comfortably. In the third, he nearly won the set three straight but Steve hung in there and sneaked a 12-10 win. In the fourth end, Rob retained control and won it 11-7. That's a good win over a player ten places above him in the averages. 7-3 to Morpeth was the final score. Castaways and Sparta enjoyed a sociable evening in a match that gave plenty of time for post-match drinks. Nine ends finished three straight plus Peter Tokely took an end off Norman Grant. Steve Hattrill was Sparta's star, beating Norman Grant in three. 9-1 to Castaways but I fear the title race is lost. A week of fixtures ending in runaway victories was completed by PRO's 9-1 defeat of Treasury B. This was closer than the score suggests with only four sets ending three straight. David Shore was Treasury's best player, taking an end off John Crawford and beating George Buck. Best set of the night was again the doubles where Treasury led after three ends, lost the fourth end and just fell short in the fifth by 11-7.
