A.O.B

The committee have proposed the following rule change to bring in line with 8 division teams.

#### Existing Rules

6.8. If any team withdraws from the Association during the course of the first half of the season, the results will be deleted. For any team withdrawing in the second half of the season, all results from the first half will stand, the remainder will be deleted. Withdrawing clubs must notify the League Secretary, who will, in turn, notify all other Club Secretaries.

6.15. A registered player may play for a higher rated team in any division. A player may though only play 3 times against any other team during a season. The exception is that a player registered with the lowest team (i.e. by letter or number) in a Club and any player registered with a team in the bottom division may play 4 times against any other team.

Proposed rule change, catering for divisions of 8, 10 or 12 teams.

6.8. If any team withdraws from the Association during the first half of the season (divisions 10/12) or first third (divisions of 8), the results will be deleted. For any team withdrawing in the second half (divisions of 10/12) or second third (divisions of 8) of the season, all results from the first half / first third will stand, For any team withdrawing in the 3<sup>rd</sup> part of the season (divisions of 8) the first two thirds will stand, the remainder will be deleted. Any matches outstanding will be adjudicated by the committee. Withdrawing clubs must notify the League Secretary, who will, in turn, notify all other Club Secretaries.

6.15. A registered player may play for a higher rated team in any division. A player may though only play 3 times (divisions of 10/12) or 4 times (divisions of 8) against any other team during a season. The exception is that a player registered with the lowest team (i.e. by letter or number) in a Club and any player registered with a team in the bottom division may play 4 (divisions of 10/12) or 5 times (divisions of 8) against any other team.

Proposed entry fees for teams next season will be £90/ team.
