The popular game of Table Tennis has "taken" in Maidstone most thoroughly, as proved by the numerous entries for the tournament commenced in the Corn Exchange in October 1902. The first open event of its kind played in the town. Organised by local tennis player and sportsman Mr T.H.Oyler a farmer from Hollingbourne the event attracted 60 Players.



90th Year celebrations 2009

Memorable Historical Table Tennis Facts.

- 1900 Originally played under the Trademark Name of Ping Pong with hard paddles.
- 1901 Pimpled rubber added to hard wooden blade & celluloid ball used.
- 1926/7 ETTA. ITTF Founded. First official World Table tennis Championships in London.
- 1929 Fred Perry first Englishman to win World Championships in Budapest.
- 1930s World Table Tennis dominated by Hungarians. Victor Barna 5 times World Champion
- 1936 Net height changed from 6 – 6.75 “. Single point at World Champs. lasted 2 hours!
- 1937 Richard Bergman, Austrian & British international player wins 4 World Singles titles.
- 1938 Net height back to 6”, finger spin serves banned, expedite rule introduced.
- 1947 England ladies team win world title 2 years running.
- 1949- Johnny Leach from England wins the first of 2 World Singles Titles.
- 1950 Rumanian Angelica Rozeanu-Adelstein wins World Ladies Singles 5 years running.
- 1950 Bats first made with sponge sandwiched under pimples to get extra spin.
- 1952 Japanese Horoji Satoh wins World Title with excessively thick sponge bat.
- 1952 – 69 China & Japan dominate World Table Tennis Single & Team events.
- 1959 ITTF legislation standardises total thickness of sponge, thick sponge banned.
- 1960s Reverse rubber developed, forehand Loop first used. Combination bats appeared.
- 1962 Mary Wright (Shannon) wins first of 6 English Ladies Singles titles.
- 1963 Chester Barnes (christened George) wins first of 5 English singles titles at age of 15. He became a household name and was known for his heavier square shaped bat.
- 1965 Dennis Neale from Yorkshire wins first of 6 England Men’s Singles Titles.
- 1970 Many players started using a new speed glue to gain extra speed & spin.
- 1971 First anti-loop rubber used in Nagoya World Championships by a French player.
- 1973 Jill Parker Hammersley dominates English Ladies with first of 7 singles titles.
- 1975 Desmond Douglas becomes a household name and wins first of English of 11 singles titles. and is remembered for his left handed, Scissor Jump Smash
- 1980 Unseeded John Hilton from Manchester wins European Title confusing the other World Class Players with his same coloured combination bat & twiddling.
- 1985 ITTF changes rule so that both sides of all bats are of different colour.
- 1988 Table Tennis first introduced as an event at the Seoul Olympic
- 1988 Alan Cooke from Chesterfield wins the first of 6 English Singles Titles.
- 1989 China ceases to dominate. Sweden wins Men’s Team & Singles event 3 times.
- 1995 China reasserts its control over all Men’s & Women’s World Events.
- 2000 Brief blip by Chinese allows Sweden to win World Team Title once more.
- 2000 ITTF rules the ball diameter to be increased from 38mm – 40mm to slow game down.
- 2001 Frictionless long pimples & speed gluing up before games becomes popular.
- 2001 ETTA changes from 21 point games to 11 points. Change of serve after 2 points.
- 2002 Service rule change, must strike ball on way down, no shielding from umpire.
- 2006 ITTF bans use of long frictionless pimples and use of speed glues.
- 2007 Paul Drinkhall from Middlesborough wins first of 6 English singles titles.
- 2014 ITTF changes from 40 mm ‘seamed’ balls to ‘seamless’ poly material.

Grand Prix King, Ryan Jenkins has achieved a string of achievements during his distinguished Table Tennis career. Twelve times Welsh National Champion, Ryan has represented his country in four Commonwealth Games where he has collected 6 medals.

Ryan has been a regular face on the UK tournament circuit where he has claimed 54 individual Grand Prix titles and been overall

Grand Prix champion an impressive (and so far, unbeaten) eight times. Internationally, Ryan has earned 258 caps for Wales and has played in the National Leagues of Britain, Sweden, Denmark, Switzerland, Germany and Belgium. He became Welsh National Coaching Manager in 2009 and since retiring from international play in 2016 has dedicated more of his time to raise the profile of Welsh Table Tennis.

Ryan is renowned as a gentleman of Table Tennis, always encouraging younger players and supporting the sport. Furthermore, he is an active promoter of the table tennis cancer charity 'Pink Pong' where he has led several fundraising challenges. Whilst his international career may have ended, Ryan has now made the transition into Veteran Table Tennis, where there are new titles to be claimed.
