#### DETAILS OF PLAYERS APPEARING THIS EVENING

**Kevin Read (Writtle TTC)** In his early years, Kevin won local league and county titles in Singles, Doubles and team events in Kent, Bedfordshire and Buckinghamshire. He then gave up table tennis for a number of years before starting again in Essex. A former Mens Singles winner in the Burnham, Brentwood, Basildon and Southend Leagues, with a range of Doubles and team titles to his name, Kevin has represented his county as a Junior, Senior, and more recently in the Veterans first team for Essex. His last appearance at Finals Night saw him lose a thrilling Mens Singles Semi Final to Rik James in 2008.

Keith Adams (Danbury TTC) Began playing table tennis in the Silvertown League in 1982 at Fairbairn House, home club of Essex legend Skylet Andrew. Keith played there until 1996 when the League folded. After concentrating on Athletics he returned to table tennis in 2007 and has won the Brentwood Mens Singles title, the Basildon Veterans Singles crown on two occasions, and numerous Doubles titles. He currently plays in five local Leagues and the Veterans British League. Last year's Chelmsford Veterans Singles Champion, this year he will be looking to retain his Veterans singles crown and to add the Mens Singles title to his list.

<u>Saul Chivers (Chelmsford TTC)</u> This is Saul's first appearance at Chelmsford Finals Night. He began playing table tennis for Chelmsford TTC in the Chelmsford Junior League the age of 13. He was a member of the team which won the National Junior League top division in 2022, and he now plays in both the Senior and Junior British Leagues for Chelmsford TTC. He is currently ranked 128<sup>th</sup> in the National Junior Category. Last year Saul qualified for both the Jack Petchey Foundation Finals and the Regional Schools Tournament.

Lee McHugh (Writtle TTC) Braintree Mens Singles Champion in 2019, this is Lee's third appearance at Finals Night, having won the Mixed Doubles in 2020 and been runner up in the Mens Doubles the same year. Last year he won a new event – the Under 40s Singles, and this time round he was runner up in this event. Lee is a prolific and innovative Table Tennis Coach who has helped numerous Juniors at a wide range of local Clubs, including Chelmsford TTC, Buttsbury TTC, Danbury TTC, Tollgate TTC and Writtle TTC.

Harry Chivers (Chelmsford TTC) This is Harry's first appearance at Finals Night. He started playing in 2018 and like his brother Saul he has progressed rapidly through the world of Junior Table Tennis. He is currently ranked 102<sup>nd</sup> in the National Junior Category, and he has reached the Finals in various 1 Star and 2 Star tournaments across the country. Last year he played for the Chelmsford team which won the National Junior League Division 1 title, and he is currently playing in both the Junior and Senior British Leagues.

Toby McLewin (Danbury TTC) Toby began playing at Tollgate TTC in Colchester where he has won both the Cadet and Junior titles. He now trains at Britannia TTC in Ipswich where he is coached by Aad Kwakkelstein. He plays for Britannia TTC in both the Senior and Junior British Leagues and is currently ranked 71st in the National Junior Category. He has played for Essex Junior first and second teams and the first team finished runners-up recently in the County Championships Premier Division. This will be Toby's first Chelmsford Finals Night appearance.

<u>Duncan Taylor (Writtle TTC)</u> Vastly experienced player who was a top 10 ranked England Junior back in the day. Former Mens Singles Champion in the Basildon, Burnham, Chelmsford and Southend Leagues. Winner of both the Mens Singles and Veterans Singles in the 2022 Burnham tournament. Vast County playing experience including playing for the Essex Veterans first team. Duncan currently plays in the Veterans British League.

Bruce Kettle (Danbury TTC) Bruce played as a Junior at the Fellows Cranleigh Club where he was coached by the legendary Wally Read in a group which included such luminaries as Bob Potton, Les Eadie, Ian Horsham, Stuart Gibbs, Bobby Stevens, Dave Brown, Dave Bowles, Leslie and Peter Radford, Peter Hunt, and Bob and Janet Hellaby. Working as a Youth and Community worker it became harder for him to play in local Leagues because of work commitments but despite this Bruce has played in the following Leagues in Essex at one time or another – East London, Central London. Ilford, Romford, Becontree, Waltham Forest, Brentwood, Basildon. Burnham, Chelmsford and Southend. Last year's Mens Doubles winner, he had a very good tournament weekend winning both the Over 60s singles and the Hardbat Singles.

Trevor Lloyd (Danbury TTC) Has already won two Over 40s Veterans Singles titles and three Over 60s Singles titles in Chelmsford since moving to Essex from his native Wiltshire. In Wiltshire he won no fewer than 12 Mens Singles titles in the West Wiltshire League as well as four Wiltshire County Mens Singles titles. Played over 100 times for Wiltshire in County matches. Current member of Essex Over 60s first team. Last year's Men Doubles winner he will be looking to retain that title.

<u>Paul Davison (Danbury TTC)</u> Six times Braintree Mens Singles Champion. Frequent title winner at the Chelmsford Tournament which includes successes in the Mens Doubles and Mixed Doubles as well as Semi-Final appearances in the Mens Singles. Plays in the Veterans British League having also played in the Senior British League

<u>Dawn Baldry (Maldon TTC)</u> - defending her Ladies' Singles title Dawn is also a multiple winner of the Ladies' Singles, Ladies Doubles and Mixed Doubles titles in the Burnham League Tournament.

Andrea Alleyne (Maldon TTC) Began playing aged 18, and gave up to start a family. She started playing again 12 years ago and now plays for Maldon TTC in the Chelmsford League and Blackwater TTC in the Burnham League. Andrea won the Ladies Doubles at the weekend with Dawn Baldry and last year she won the Mixed Doubles with Duncan Taylor in the Burnham League Tournament. This will be her first Chelmsford Finals Night appearance.
